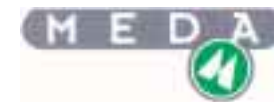

Abstract Competition: Rules of Judgement

All submitted abstracts can be presented at the annual meeting.

The jury will consist of the foreign, non-Belgian speakers and the members of the scientific committee.

Two categories are proposed: clinical and experimental. The authors of the abstract can indicate their preference for one of the two categories. If no preference is indicated, the chairman of the scientific committee will select the category. The best abstract presented by a resident form both categories will be awarded the „resident award“.

Each juror gives a mark varying from 0 (extremely bad) to 100 (excellent) to each abstract. Based on these marks, abstracts are placed from position 1 to ?. This is done for each abstract by each individual juror.

When all jurors have send their marks and a list of positions, the list of positions is then used to determine the final position of each individual abstract by adding the different positions together for each abstract. The abstract with the lowest total score in each category wins the competition. Abstracts are not blinded.

The use of the official abstract form of the BSAR is mandatory. Abstract forms are to be collected from the BSAR secretariat (See below).

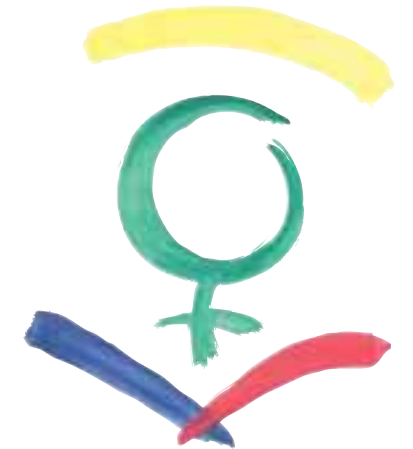
