On behalf of all the SARB board members, we wish you an enjoyable and interesting congress!

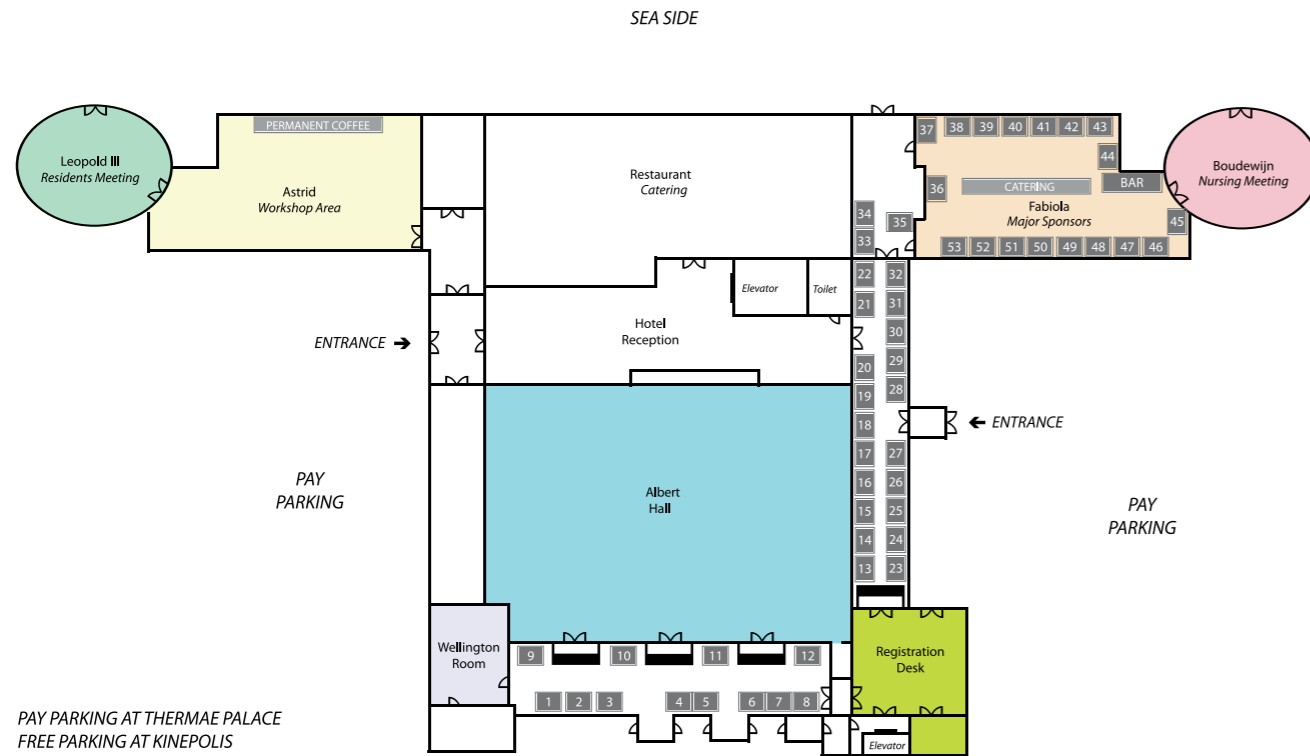

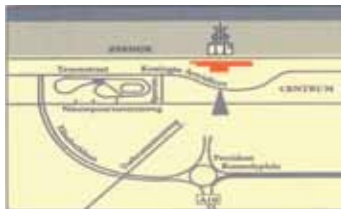
